### Insights

- v. 1 – A middle-eastern deer...in a \_\_\_\_\_ area
- v. 2 – *thirst* = \_\_\_\_\_ *appear* = \_\_\_\_\_ before face of God
- v. 3 – *tears are my food* = \_\_\_\_\_ *detractors* \_\_\_\_\_
- v. 4 – *pour out my soul* = my soul \_\_\_\_\_  
Remembers when he \_\_\_\_\_ with God's people at feasts
- v. 5 – *despair* = bowed down *disturbed* = make noise, \_\_\_\_\_  
*hope* = \_\_\_\_\_ *help* = salvation (of His \_\_\_\_\_)
- v. 6 – Psalmist bares his soul \_\_\_\_\_; remembers \_\_\_\_\_
- v. 7 – *deep calls to deep* = a picture of being \_\_\_\_\_
- v. 8 – A picture of \_\_\_\_\_ with God
- v. 9 – God, why have you forgotten me?  
Why is it growing \_\_\_\_\_ as the \_\_\_\_\_ oppresses me?
- v. 10 – The hostile taunts of my enemies \_\_\_\_\_
- v. 11 – Soul: *despair* → \_\_\_\_\_; countenance: *sadness* → \_\_\_\_\_
