37:2-11 – his brothers / his
37:12-36 – sold as a by his brothers
39:1-6 – Potiphar's servant → the LORD was Joseph
$39:6-20$ - resisted $\rightarrow$ put in (unjustly)
$39:21-23$ – chief jailer's servant $\rightarrow$ the LORD was Joseph
40:1-23 – Joseph interprets of Pharaoh's cupbearer & baker
• vv. 15, 23 – the cupbearer Joseph
41:1-36 – Joseph interprets of Pharaoh – gave glory to God
$41:37-45$ – favored by Pharaoh $\rightarrow$ appointed over Egypt
41:46ff – Lord prospered Joseph through abundance and famine
• Father & brothers came and to him
Take-Away – Joseph did what was right in God's sightday-by-day
Even when morally tempted by Potiphar's wife
He knew that she belonged to

• He did not with sin (Prov. 5:8)
