**v. 1** – Like Ps. \_\_\_\_\_: *in the day the Lord delivered David from* \_\_\_\_\_

**vv. 2-7** – David gives praise for God's \_\_\_\_\_

- Titles of God's protection (2-3)
- David \_\_\_\_\_ upon the Lord (4-7)

**vv. 8-20** – Praise for God's \_\_\_\_\_ against David's enemies

**vv. 21-32** – David praises God for His \_\_\_\_\_

- His justice – the law of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt. 5:7-8)
- His grace – to the \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt. 5:3; Ps. 138:6)
- God is my \_\_\_\_\_ (29); and my \_\_\_\_\_ (30)
- God is \_\_\_\_\_ & His word is true (31); God is \_\_\_\_\_ (32)

**vv. 33-50** – David praises God for His \_\_\_\_\_

- Blameless – a champion of moral \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Tim. 3:2, 10)
- \_\_\_\_\_ = single – single-\_\_\_\_\_ devotion (Mt. 6:24)  
Col. 3:5-7

*Negative* ⇒ God's \_\_\_\_\_

- Perverted or \_\_\_\_\_ – twist God's \_\_\_\_\_ (Jude 4)
- \_\_\_\_\_ = *I'm better than* \_\_\_\_\_; *God's laws don't* \_\_\_\_\_  
*to me*
